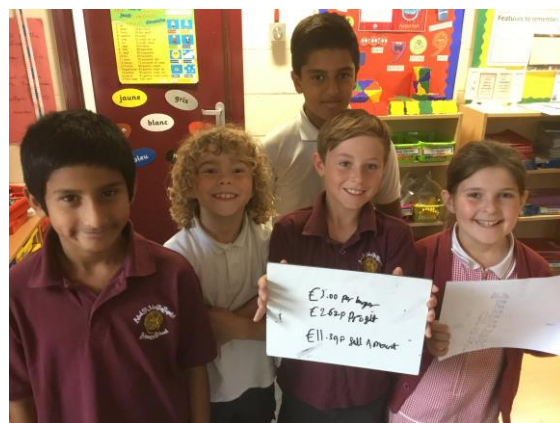
Headteacher's Message
