Headteacher's Message

Welcome back, for our final term. We started on Tuesday focusing, as always, on our PSHE curriculum. The curriculum for this half term covers: money matters and drug, alcohol and tobacco education (KS1), physical health and wellbeing and sex and relationships (both in Lower KS2 curriculum) and how to keep safe and manage risks (upper KS2 curriculum.) Utilising the first day of a new half term to teach this important curriculum area ensures our children are given time to consider the knowledge, understanding and skills they need to manage their lives now and in the future. It also emphasizes the importance we place on teaching PSHE before they start their topic learning.

It is with some disappointment then that I must report that 16 children missed this essential element of the curriculum as they remained on holiday after the half-term.

Today we completed a revaluation of our Healthy Schools Status. This considers our Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education, Physical Activity, Healthy Eating and Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH). 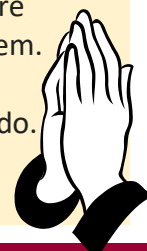


Good Hygiene

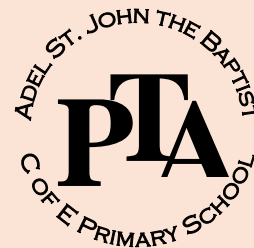
Prayer

Hollybank Eccup 10 Mile and Junior Races

Sunday 30 June 2019

Abbey Runners are hosting their annual series of Eccup 10 races on Sunday 30th June and our school is hosting the race HQ again this year. Abbey Runners are linking up again with their sponsor and charitable partner, the Hollybank Trust and the club's nominated Charity this year is Solace – a Leeds based charity providing psychotherapy support for asylum seekers and refugees living in the Yorkshire and Humber region. Abbey Runners will be making a donation to both charities from the race proceeds.

As well as the 10 mile race for adults, there are two junior races (1 mile and 2 mile). The Junior races are run entirely on grass on a one-mile loop around Bedquilts playing fields. School years 3-6 will run one lap of the course with two laps for school years 7-12. Advance entries (£3) to junior races can be made online at www.racebest.com where you will find details of the course. After the junior races, a family fun run will also take place on a 1km grass course on Bedquilts and entries for this will be on the day.
