### Headteacher's Message

Welcome back to the final term of the year. It's always one that is busy, but full of exciting events. Class newsletters are to be sent out on Monday with details of the teaching and learning planned.

Activities have already started to engage and inspire the children in their new topics. As part of their Predators topic, Year 3 welcomed The Owl Experience to learn more about this nocturnal creature's habitat and diet. The highlight was seeing one of the owls swoop across the hall! Year 4 have visited Leeds City Museum this afternoon to start their Romans topic, they dressed a Roman soldier, looked at Roman artefacts and made a Roman helmet and Leeds Rhinos visited a very excited Year 1 to start their weekly rugby sessions.

Our outdoor learning has been enhanced even further over the holidays; the introduction of three large maps in the KS2 playground has sparked huge interest from the children. Their first challenge was to discover who in their class had travelled the furthest and many have been keen to trace the route they travel to school on the local map. We have also added signs to support the teaching of British Values now statutory in all schools to prepare pupils for 'life in Britain'. One of these values is the importance of democracy, something that has been illustrated perfectly with the recent announcement of the General Election in June. As our school will be used as a polling station, we have decided to use this day as our final training day (*see diary*).

Staff and children in Year 5 are excited about the residential next week. The coach is booked to leave at 9.30am on Monday morning, please can we ask that people park away from the turning circle to allow space for the coach to arrive and leave. Please can we ask all parents to check their child's hair over this weekend; a case has been reported.



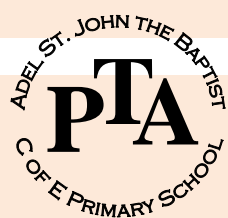
### Sainsbury's Active Kids Vouchers
