Headteacher's Message

Congratulations to our Year 6 children who completed their SAT's this week. It was a privilege to be with the children in the hall. To see how they approached the tests with calmness and maturity, to witness the effort they put in and hear the cheer when it was all over.

The children are now ready to concentrate on their transition. Some of the high school staff will be coming in to meet the children and, of course, they have the opportunity of visiting their allocated high schools. Change is often worrying (as well as exciting) for them but we do make huge efforts to make this as easy as possible for the children.

Next week is Walk to School Week so Adel St John will be taking part again in the initiative that aims to promote congestion busting, healthy and environmentally friendly ways of travelling to school. We have organised a different theme each day in an effort to brighten the walk to school.

Monday is Marching Monday, so we can expect a lot of tired parents and children arriving at 8.50am, see below for the themes for the rest of the week.

We intend to have at least three staff from school standing at four points around the area. Parents and children may join them there at 8.35am to walk to school together.

Every day over the week, we will be surveying the journey children make and recording those walking to school. Your children may be classed as walking to school if they walk all the way from home or if they walk 500 metres (that is 0.31 mile) from where they get out of the car.

Another will be at the corner of St Helen's Lane and Long Causeway, the entrance to Bedquilts on Church Lane opposite the Rectory and finally Adel Wood Stores. 
Marching Monday: Step out in time with ASJ! Times table Tuesday: Choose a times table to recite with a friend or parent
