- Working Tax Credit Run On (but not Regular Working Tax Credit)
- Support Under Part 1V of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit if you don't get any Working Tax Credit and the combined income of you and your partner doesn't exceed £16,190 per year).
