Important Safeguarding information

We have very clear instructions for children leaving school at the end of day in Key Stage 2. They should go straight to the adult collecting them. If no one is there they then return inside and wait in the cloakroom with supervising staff.

- Do not allow other children to stand with you to wait for their parent – instruct them to return to the cloakroom or bring them to the office.
- If a parent does ask you to take their child home, ask them to contact school immediately or come to the office yourself so that we are aware and can gather parent permission.

By following these two points we can ensure our children are following school procedure and avoid confusion and worry for staff and parents.

There are a number of viruses around at the moment, including slapped cheek, which Adel St John and other schools in the Cluster are hearing of. The symptoms of this illness include high temperature, runny nose, sore throat and headache. After 1-3 days with a cheek rash, a light pink body rash may appear. Once this happens, children are no longer infectious and can be in school. While this virus isn't nice for children there can be a small risk for women in early pregnancy, if you think you may be at risk the advice is to see your GP, midwife or call NHS 111.
