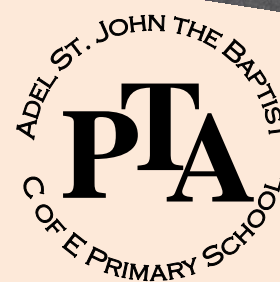
All Star Cricket Scheme
