Easter Roadworks

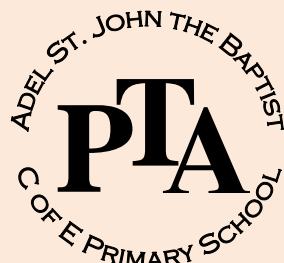
The roadworks to introduce an Adel 20mph scheme are due to start. There will be advanced warning signs before closures come into effect but please take note of the following disruptions to travel and diversions that will be in place over the holidays and for the start of the new Summer term:

Week Commencing 9th April 2018 – All 20mph signing and lining will be introduced.

Sunday 15th April 2018 – 7am to 7pm – A road closure will be in place for Long Causeway and Sir George Martin Drive to allow the contractors to introduce the speed tables and the set of the speed cushions next to St Helens Lane, as well as some footway works. Local residents will still be able to gain access if they live within the closed area.

Monday 16th April 2018 – 9:30am-3:30pm – St Helens Lane will be closed to through traffic between Long Causeway and Adel Lane, with access for local residents being maintained throughout.

Tuesday 17th April 2018 – The two remaining set of speed cushions (next to Mulberry Avenue and Tile Lane) will be constructed using a lane closure and two-way signals. This will be done outside of the school drop off and pick up times.
