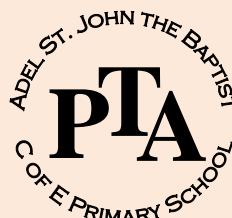

Hollybank Eccup 10 Mile and Junior Races Sunday July 1st 2018

Abbey Runners are hosting their annual series of Eccup 10 races on Sunday 1st July and our school is hosting the race HQ again this year.

As well as the 10 mile race for adults, there are two junior races (1 mile and 2 mile). The Junior races are run entirely on grass on a one-mile loop around Bedquilts playing fields. School years 3-6 will run one lap of the course with two laps for school years 7-12.
