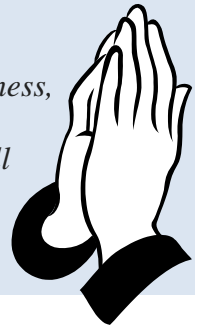
Dear God
