Fundraising Reminder

Using the Easy fund raising website is an easy way of raising money via the PTA's registered charity. It doesn't cost you anything - just shop online using their partner retailers - Amazon, John Lewis, Ebay and over 200 more. When you make purchases they donate money to the school.

Quick instructions into doing this

- 1. Go to http://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/adelstjohn/
- 2. Click on "Get Started" link and complete the registration.
- 3. Download the "Find and remind" toolbar (optional but acts as a good reminder about this)
- 4. Start shopping online and see extra funds come to the school.
