Father God, as we look forward to the excitement and celebrations of Christmas, help us not to lose sight of its true meaning.


As we open our gifts given with love, we remember how you gave the world the gift of Jesus Christ to show us how much you love each one of us. *Amen.*




Aqua Festival Success
