Safeguarding Reminder

We have very clear instructions for children leaving school at the end of day in Key Stage 2. They should go straight to the adult collecting them. If no one is there they then return inside and wait in the cloakroom with supervising staff. I would ask that you support this system by adhering to the following:

- Do not allow other children to stand with you to wait for their parent instruct them to return to the cloakroom or bring them to the office.
- If a parent does ask you to take their child home, ask them to contact school immediately or come to the office yourself so that we are aware and can gather parent permission.
