Another busy week in school and the end to another very full half term. This week Year 2 were visited by Pirate Ron. They spent the morning learning about all things pirate before watching an interactive pirate puppet show. In the afternoon the children learnt how to make their own puppets. Year 3 have been learning about soil this week and have considered how we can be environmentally friendly by using waste food to create compost. They made mini

composters in the classroom for snack waste.

As part of their Frozen Kingdom topic, Rev White visited Year 6 this week. He talked about milk and dairy production and the children then made different flavoured frozen yoghurts!

Our Eco Committee visited the Civic Hall on Tuesday. They toured the Council

chambers and met and offered questions to the Lord Mayor. They had an opportunity to put questions to councillors, learn about democracy and see the council plans to tackle climate change. This morning they led an assembly for the whole school. They did a great job of explaining what climate

change is and how everyone can make a difference by changing one small thing.

The Eco Committee are also playing a big part in our Science Week – 'A Diverse Planet' which starts on the 9th March. They are leading one of our focus days and will be writing to parents after half-term to explain the Climate Strike Day. To confirm all children WILL be in school that day but the focus will be very much on awareness of the emergency our planet is facing. The children are also taking over the playground during the afternoon to make their voices heard in a 'strike.'

Enjoy a relaxing half term break and we look forward to welcoming the children back in school on Monday 24th February.
