Dear Parents and Carers,

We are welcoming Miss Griffin back to the Year 1 class, from 10th May. She has been on maternity leave and will come back and continue to share the week with Miss Riches. Mr Smithson, our supply teacher who is covering Year 5, has gone on paternity leave. Due to this I am covering my Y5 class alongside Mrs Starkey. Please understand it may take longer than normal for me to respond to you and you may not see me on a morning welcoming the children to school.

Homework at ASJ

I wanted to give a quick update on homework. We are not sending home learning logs as yet, this is to reduce the risk of COVID19 transmission with paper being sent home and then coming back into school. When restrictions are reduced we can go back to normal but, for now, homework remains as follows:

Y1 – Y6 Weekly spellings are introduced in school and uploaded to Seesaw to learn at home.

Y2 - Y6 Online Mathletics x3 activities are set weekly.

All children should be aiming to read to an adult every day for a minimum of ten minutes. Remember to discuss what is read with questions and talk about the meanings of new words to boost vocabulary.

Just a reminder the photographer is in school next Wednesday to take class photos. Year groups 2, 4 and 5 have PE that day so we suggest they come in school uniform for the purpose of the photos. For these classes, we may do PE another day or manage the lesson in school uniform.

I mentioned last week about parents' evenings and can now confirm the dates will be 18th and 19th May. The parents evening meetings are going to be held on a website called SchoolCloud. Details of how to book your time slot are on the final pages of today's newsletter. Bookings can be made from **8am on Tuesday 4th May.** The system syncs with our admin system called SIMS so it uses the email address we have for you on our system. You will only need to book the one appointment per child. You will have a ten-minute meeting with your child's teacher(s) the same as our regular system used in the past. If for any reason you can't make those dates or times, then let your child's class teacher know. They may be able to arrange another day straight after school when they can make a phone call to you. On this occasion the only dates we can meet with you on video appointments are 18th and 19th May. As always please don't wait until parents evening to share any safeguarding issues or something else that is happening that you want school to help out with. It is a new system to us all, so we recognise there could be teething problems with it, please get in touch with the office if you need some support with your online booking and we will do our best to help.



Parents' Guide for Booking Appointments schoolcloud

Step 1: Login

Fill out the details on the page then click the Log In button.

A confirmation of your appointments will be sent to the email address you provide.



Step 2: Select Parents' Evening

Click on the date you wish to book.

Unable to make the dates listed? Click I'm unable to attend.



Step 4: Choose Teachers

If you chose the automatic booking mode, drag the sliders at the top of the screen to indicate the earliest and latest you can attend.

Select the teachers you'd like to book appointments with. A green tick indicates they're selected. To de-select, click on their name.



Step 5a (Automatic): Book Appointments

If you chose the automatic booking mode, you'll see provisional appointments which are held for 2 minutes. To keep them, choose Accept at the bottom left.

If it wasn't possible to book every selected teacher during the times you are able to attend, you can either adjust the teachers you wish to meet with and try again, or switch to manual booking mode (Step 5b).



Step 5b (Manual): Book Appointments

Click any of the green cells to make an appointment. Blue cells signify where you already have an appointment. Grey cells are unavailable.

To change an appointment, delete the original by hovering over the blue box and clicking *Delete*. Then choose an alternate time.

Once you're finished booking all appointments, at the top of the page in the alert box, press *click here* to finish the booking process.



Step 6: Finished

All your bookings now appear on the My Bookings page. An email confirmation has been sent and you can also print appointments by pressing Print. Click Subscribe to Calendar to add these and any future bookings to your calendar.

To change your appointments, click on *Amend Bookings*.
