
On this last day of term, Year 4 have finished their topic on the Romans with a Roman Day. The chil-

♦ Any child presenting symptoms should not be brought to school. Any adult presenting symptoms should not drop off or pick up their child. A PCR test should be booked. We encourage all parents/carers to err on the side of caution; if in doubt,

book a PCR test.

- If family members test positive or your child has had close contact with someone who has tested positive, a PCR test should be booked.
- Twice weekly LFT testing is still encouraged while cases are high in the community. Click here for <u>'Helping your child with doing a test'</u>
- Only one parent/carer is to drop off and collect. Adults are encouraged to socially distance when waiting. Parents/carers to leave the school area promptly once you have dropped off/ collected.
