#### **COVID RULES FOR ATTENDING NEXT WEEK'S NATIVITY**

It is really important to us at ASJ that parents and carers of our youngest children can come into school to enjoy our Christmas Nativity play. Events like this are memories to be cherished, which is why we are making every effort to make this event happen. I ask that every parent and carer attending ensures they have read and adhere to the following precautions:

- This event is a ticketed event. Each family has been allocated two tickets. If you do not have a ticket or arrive with young children you will be refused entry. Unfortunately, this includes babies. Please do not place my staff in the difficult situation of having to refuse you entry for not following this request.
- If you are displaying symptoms, have tested positive on a LFT or PCR or are living with someone who is displaying symptoms or who has tested positive **you must not attend the performance**.
- Before attending a performance, we ask that you take a lateral flow test. This is now government guidance. Click <u>here</u> to find out where LFT tests can be obtained.
- The afternoon performances start at 2:15pm, the evening at 6:30pm.
   Doors will be opened 5 minutes before the performance begins.
   We ask parents to queue outside the main entrance, socially distancing.
- All adults are to wear a mask when entering school and while watching the performance. If you are medically exempt from wearing a mask we ask that you contact school on the number above to make us aware.
- There will be no access to toilet facilities whilst in school.
- At the end of the performance we ask you leave immediately via the hall doors and walk around the outside of the building to collect your child from their cloakroom door. Please do not congregate inside the school building.
- The hall doors and windows will be open to enable adequate ventilation so there could be a cool draft, depending on the weather.
- Finally, we hope you enjoy this special event. I very much look forward to welcoming you into school.
