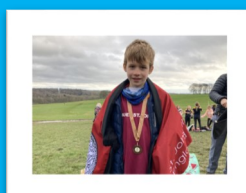

to stay safe while online. From the role play they learned to always ask permission from a trusted adult, to use strong safe passwords and never share private information.



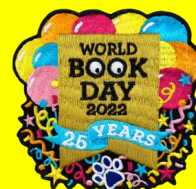
PTA Christmas card and raffle raised an amazing £973. this money is going towards a set of virtual reality headsets for children to use in lessons.

Leeds SENDIASS workshops

The workshops will be presented by our experienced officers. The aim of the sessions is to give information, advice and support to parents and carers, and to explain processes clearly. There will also be an opportunity to ask questions and request support materials such as guides, fact sheets and FAQ sheets.

SEND Support in schools

The workshop will cover: What SEND support can be accessed in school, preparing for and attending SEND meetings, the Graduated Response, reasonable adjustments, and support from other agencies.

Education, Health and Care (EHC) Needs Assessments Application

The workshop will cover: How to request an assessment, guidance for filling in the application forms and information on the process including timelines.

The workshop will cover: Preparing for and attending a review meeting, requesting a change of setting, calling an early review, updating the content of a plan and what to do if you are unhappy with the review process or outcome

The workshop will cover: Appealing decisions to the SEND tribunal in relation to an EHC needs assessment, including mediation, the tribunal process and preparing paperwork.

The workshop will cover: Preparing for adulthood, EHCP reviews and updating the content of the plan, and post 16 placement.
