Headteacher's News



<u>Visiting Author</u> This Wednesday, our Year 5 and 6 children had a fascinating afternoon with a visit from the author, Julia Edwards. She shared lots of interesting (and disgusting!) details about the settings of her historical fiction series, from the toilets of the Romans to the horrors of the slave trade, before we had a go at some of our own writing, trying to

infer characteristics rather than explicitly giving them away. It was quite tricky but there were some fantastic attempts and confident recitals! And some children even got books signed by the author herself!
