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

#### **Eco-Committee Litter Pick**

As mentioned on the previous newsletter, the Eco-Committee have helped to organise a litter pick to help towards our school gaining our Eco-Schools Green Flag Award and to help support the 'Great British Spring Clean 2022'.

With the help of 'Litter Free Adel', who have loaned us 6 adult and 6 child litter pickers as well as 50 purple litter bags, we hope that you and your family will help us to complete our British Spring Clean pledge to collect 50 bags of rubbish!

All the equipment and bags will be available from Friday 11th March to Thursday 31st March. You will be able to help yourself to these from the school entrance. All we ask is that if you borrow a litter picker you sign it out and back in on the sheet that will be with the equipment and only keep it for a maximum of 2 days or feel free just to take a bag and find some gloves to do your litter picking.

Once you have filled a bag, it must be placed by a Leeds City Council bin for collection. At drop off and pick up, please could parents and carers be respectful to our local residents and not block people's driveways. Please also avoid parking on Wayland Approach.

Reminder that parents and carers should not be stopping on the yellow zig-zags outside school, including the entrance and exit route to the driveway outside school.
