weeks. Also, we still have places available at all ses-

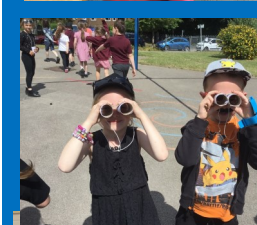
