Book Fair on **Monday 28th November - Thursday 1st December**, we will be running a Scholastic Book Fair in the school entrance after school. We have run these successfully in the past and would love you to come and peruse the books with a view to purchasing one (or two!), to both encourage reading for pleasure for your child but also to support school in raising money for new library books. **Click here to access the Book Fair magazine** on our school website for further details. Please note the following information which is in addition to that on the poster:

- There will be a sign-up sheet for parents to say when they plan to attend the book fair this will be limited to 30 parents per afternoon, between 3.30 and 4pm. As we are running the fair in the entrance hall, we will have to stagger people coming into the book fair
 so please be aware that you may not be able to enter until 4pm.
- Our book fair will be cashless. There will be no cash payments accepted on the day.
- All payments must be made via the QR code displayed at the book fair. Your 7-digit reference number will then be shown to one of our ASJ members of staff, who will sign off to say you can take the book home. Should the QR code system encounter any problems, you will be allowed to put the book aside until the next morning, taking a 'wish list' home to try again at home. If we receive your wish list back the following morning, your child will be able to take their books home that day. If not, the book will be returned to the bookshelves and could be purchased by someone else.
