Easter Holiday Club: Over the Easter break, we are opening a holiday club to our pupils. Have a wonderful half term break and the team and I at ASJ look forward to welcoming you back to school on **Monday 20th February**. Warmest regards, Mr Dalrymple



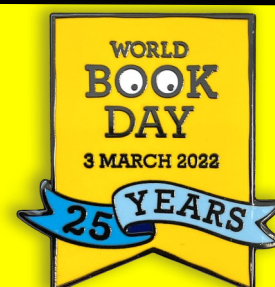
