- Prayers may be decorated and should be on A4 paper (white or coloured).
- The name of the author of the prayer, age, and school should be written on the reverse of the paper.
- Those whose prayers are to be included in the special exhibition in the Cathedral and those whose prayers are to be included in the regional service, will be informed by email to their school on Friday 21st April.
- Prayers to be sent into your child's school by Monday 27th March
